## RESTRICTED DENTAL FACULTY

<u>24-03-79</u> Jorge Vera-Rojas Buffalo, New York

(National Autonomous University of Mexico, Mexico City, Mexico, Bachelor of Dental Science, August 1991)

Petition for: Acceptance of education.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Section 6604-b of Article 133 of the Education Law requires an applicant for restricted dental faculty license to have completed a total of no less than six academic years of preprofessional and professional education, including: courses in general chemistry, organic chemistry, biology or zoology, and physics; and not less than four academic years of professional dental education satisfactory to the department.

Immediately after secondary school, Dr. Vera-Rojas completed a four-year professional dental education program at the National Autonomous University of Mexico in Mexico City, Mexico. Following that, he completed a two-year master's degree in Endo-Meta-Endodontics at Instituto de Estudios Avanzados en Odontologia "Dr Yury Kuttler" in Mexico City, Mexico.

Although Dr. Vera-Rojas has six years of combined education in dentistry, his education does not exhibit the pattern of two years of preprofessional education followed by a four-year dental program as expected. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Dentistry recommends that Dr. Vera-Rojas's combination of studies be accepted to fulfill the education requirement.

Petition for: Endorsement of applicant's medical license from France.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Commissioner's Regulations allow endorsement of an applicant's license from another jurisdiction if appropriate requirements are met, and the applicant has not failed any part of New York State's licensing examination. A license granted in a foreign country can be endorsed if licensure in that country is regulated by an organization designated as responsible for quality assurance and acceptable to the Board of Regents. Additionally, the applicant must satisfactorily demonstrate completion of an acceptable proficiency examination, clinical competency examination, three years of American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training or the equivalent, and five years of satisfactory professional experience.

Dr. Fessler lacks three years of accredited postgraduate training. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine has reviewed the documentation submitted in support of Dr. Fessler's application. He recommends that Dr. Fessler's training be accepted as the equivalent of the three years of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training required for licensure.

Commissioner's Regulations allow the Board of Regents to accept appropriate foreign medical licenses and diplomate certificates to fulfill the license, proficiency, and clinical competency requirements for New York State licensure by endorsement. Dr. Fessler obtained his medical license in France in 2016. His French license is active and in good standing. Additionally, Dr. Fessler was issued a Specialist Diploma in Anesthesia-Intensive Care from the Ministry of National Education, University of Antilles on April 14, 2016. He also received a University Diploma in Acute and Chronic Pain from University of Paris Cité formerly University of Paris Descartes on September 20, 2017.

The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine recommends that Dr. Fessler's French license be endorsed, and his Diploma in Acute and Chronic Pain and Specialist Diploma in Anesthesia-Intensive Care be accepted to fulfill the proficiency examination and the clinical competency requirements for endorsement.

Petition for: Endorsement of applicant's medical license from Germany.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Commissioner's Regulations allow endorsement of an applicant's license from another jurisdiction if appropriate requirements are met, and the applicant has not failed any part of New York State's licensing examination. A license granted in a foreign country can be endorsed if licensure in that country is regulated by an organization designated as responsible for quality assurance and acceptable to the Board of Regents. Additionally, the applicant must satisfactorily demonstrate completion of an acceptable proficiency examination, clinical competency examination, three years of American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training or the equivalent, and five years of satisfactory professional experience.

Dr. Merz lacks three years of accredited postgraduate training. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine has reviewed the documentation submitted in support of Dr. Merz's application. He recommends that Dr. Merz's training be accepted as the equivalent of the three years of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training required for licensure.

Commissioner's Regulations allow the Board of Regents to accept appropriate foreign medical licenses and diplomate certificates to fulfill the license, proficiency, and clinical competency requirements for New York State licensure by endorsement. Dr. Merz obtained his medical license in Germany in 2012. His German license is active and in good standing. Additionally, Dr. Merz was issued a Specialist Certification in Internal Medicine and Hematology and Oncology from the State Medical Association of Baden-Würtemberg and the District Medical Association of Nordbaden on April 15, 2019. He also received Venia Legendi (Habilitation), Privatdozent Degree from Medical Faculty Heidelberg on April 9, 2021.

The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine recommends that Dr. Merz's German license be endorsed, and his Venia Legendi Privatdozent degree and Specialist Certificate be accepted to fulfill the proficiency examination and the clinical competency requirements for endorsement.

A license granted in a foreign country can be endorsed if licensure in that country is regulated by an organization designated as responsible for quality assurance and acceptable to the Board of Regents. Additionally, the applicant must satisfactorily demonstrate completion of an acceptable proficiency examination, clinical competency examination, three years of American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training or the equivalent, and five years of satisfactory professional experience.
