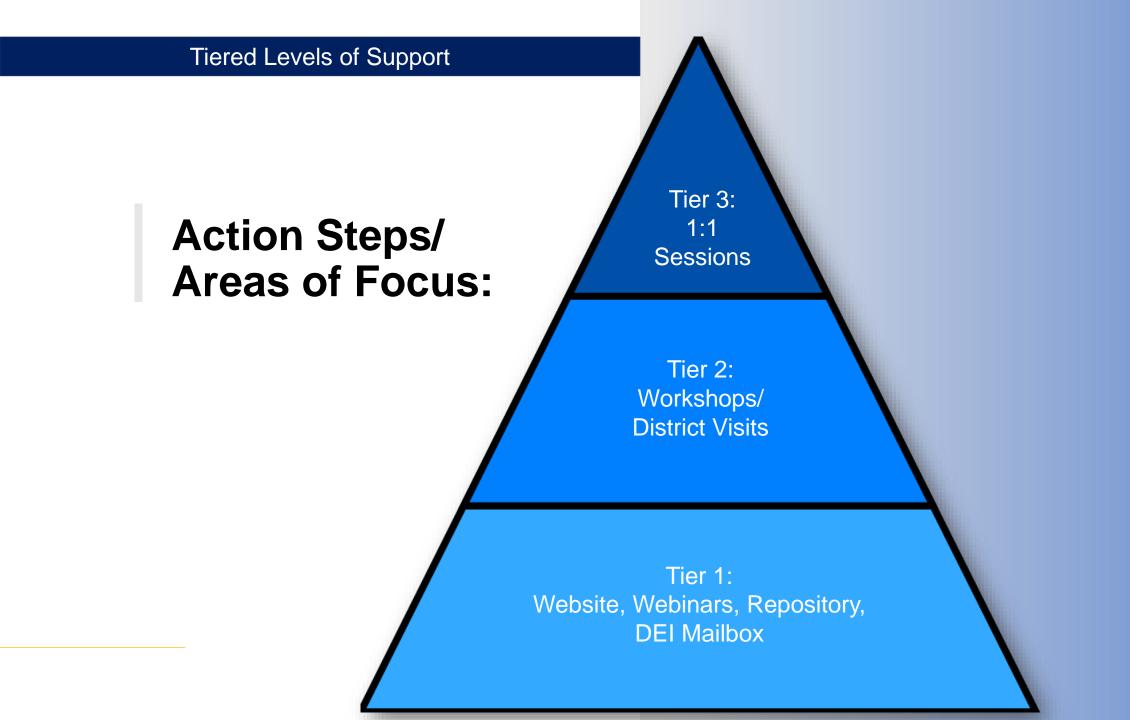

Blue: Elevating student voice in DEI initiatives

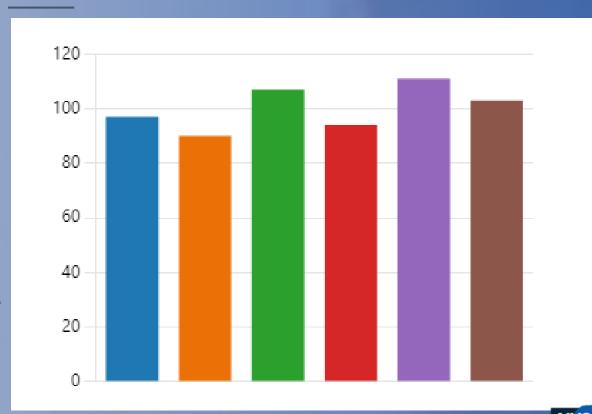
Orange: Implementing initiatives aligned with the CR-SE Framework

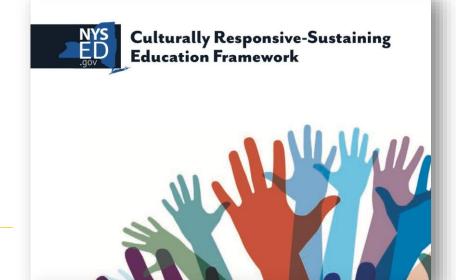

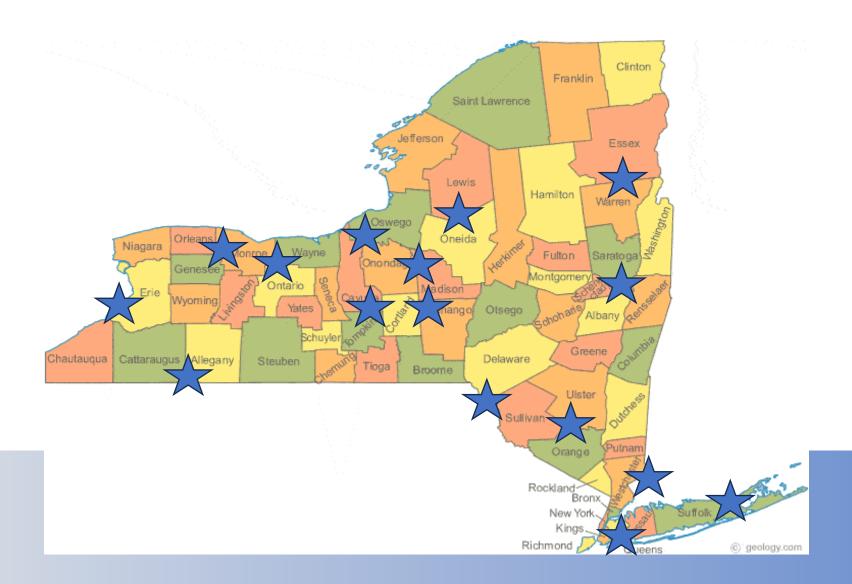

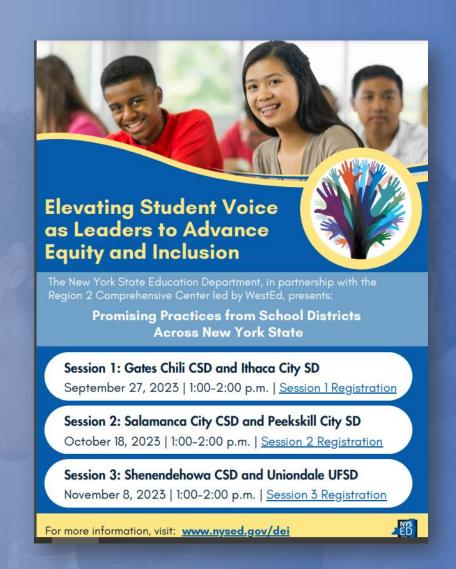
Webinar Series: Elevating Student Voice
